DVHS offers a variety of online courses to meet the academic and career-oriented goals of DoDEA eligible students. Course offerings, including Advanced Placement courses, are designed to address all DoDEA graduation requirements.

The online courses offered by DVHS have the same level of rigor, adhere to the same standards as the traditional DoDEA curriculum, and align to the same College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS).
