





The beginning of the DoD Overseas Schools story is now on display as one of more than 50 free-standing pylons, in formation, with a photo and short story of the individual etched on a block of stainless-steel measuring approximately seven feet high by two feet wide. It is an extremely impressive entry point to the massive museum. It has been a two-year plus imitative to get our foot in the door! AOSHS is working with the museum staff to have a larger presence to document the schools from their beginnings.

In 1945, **Major Virgil R. Walker** was the individual chosen, through the direction of Gen Dwight D. Eisenhower, to start up a school system that operated in occupied countries following World War II.
